



Job Description – Field Support Specialist – Los Angeles

Vision To Learn is the largest school-based vision care nonprofit in the country. VTL exists to address one basic premise – if you can't see, you can't learn. Vision To Learn provides free eye exams and free glasses to students in underserved communities to help them succeed in school and in life. Founded in Los Angeles in 2012, Vision To Learn has since expanded to schools across the country. Vision care is critical as 80% of all learning during a child's first 12 years is visual, we work to solve the problem of lack of access by partnering with school districts to provide eye exams and glasses at no charge to families. We have provided over 2 million vision screenings, 476,000 eye exams and 388,000 new, prescription glasses in the last decade.

Position Summary:

The Field Support Specialist will work with a small team that is responsible for all operations, logistics, and support the field staff located on the mobile clinic. The Field Support Specialist will ensure that all schools in the region meets their consent deadlines and that accurate student and clinical data is maintained.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Support on-site including being a runner and screener (will need multiple times per week)
- Handles routine phone call inquiries and clerical functions as needed

- Inputs, maintains, and processes all screening and consent data
- Provides support to field staff the day of visits with EMR support
- Verifies and enters patient data by reviewing, correcting, deleting, or reentering data
- Supports scheduling coordinators: periodically report problematic sites, low consent form numbers and sites that are not responsive to outreach
- Manages and updates SPARTA system: build exam rosters for sites, request needed corrections and communicate conflicting data
- Works on special projects for management as requested
- Coordinate supplies ordering for office and clinic

Who You Are:

- Accurate, organized, and detail oriented
- A self-motivated individual that can work independently and effectively with team members
- A problem solver
- Able to learn quickly
- Willing to commute / travel within county region

Qualifications:

- Excel expertise and computer literacy is required
- Filing skills (physical and digital)
- Excellent communication skills
- Experience with collecting and analyzing data and providing recommendations

Our normal work week is Monday through Friday; however, there are times that employees may need to work OT. Flexibility is a must!
