Getting Results in Ohio

The 2022-23 school year marked the second year of our “iSee with Vision To Learn project” in Appalachian Ohio, which brought care to rural communities through Ohio’s innovative ResultsOHIO pay for success program implemented by Treasurer Robert Sprague. The program met and exceeded all performance metrics during both years, enabling state funding to cover the full cost of the program.

Building on our success in Southeast Ohio, in the fall of 2022, Vision To Learn launched a dedicated clinic serving Youngstown, OH and the Mahoning Valley. In partnership with Sight For All United and the United Way of Youngstown & the Mahoning Valley, VTL expanded upon Sight For All United’s successful school vision program. In its first full year of operations, Vision To Learn provided 3,100 eye exams to students across 12 school districts in the Mahoning Valley.


A Dynamite Solution
